Description of Course

Zoo/Bot A will cover the following major topics:

Expectations and Goals

Students are expected to be respectful and follow rules and directions at all times, ask questions if uncertain about anything, monitor their grade within *Infinite Campus*, turn in assignments on time, prepare for assessments and set up make-up assessments. Plan on always trying your best and my goal is to help you be successful. All school rules and consequences apply within the classroom as well.

Classroom Rules

- 1) **Be respectful** (to yourselves, each other and staff).
- 2) **Be punctual** (seated and ready to go when bell rings).

- 4) **Raise your hand** (for a question or if need to leave classroom).

Consequences for not following the Rules above

Weighting of Grades:

25% for Homework/Classwork/Notebook/Participation

75% for Assessments/Projects/Labs

Assessment retakes or grade issues need to be discussed with me outside of class time.

*** Expect a quiz once a week and an assessment on a grander scale every 2 weeks. Also, expect quizzes and exams to be cumulative.**
